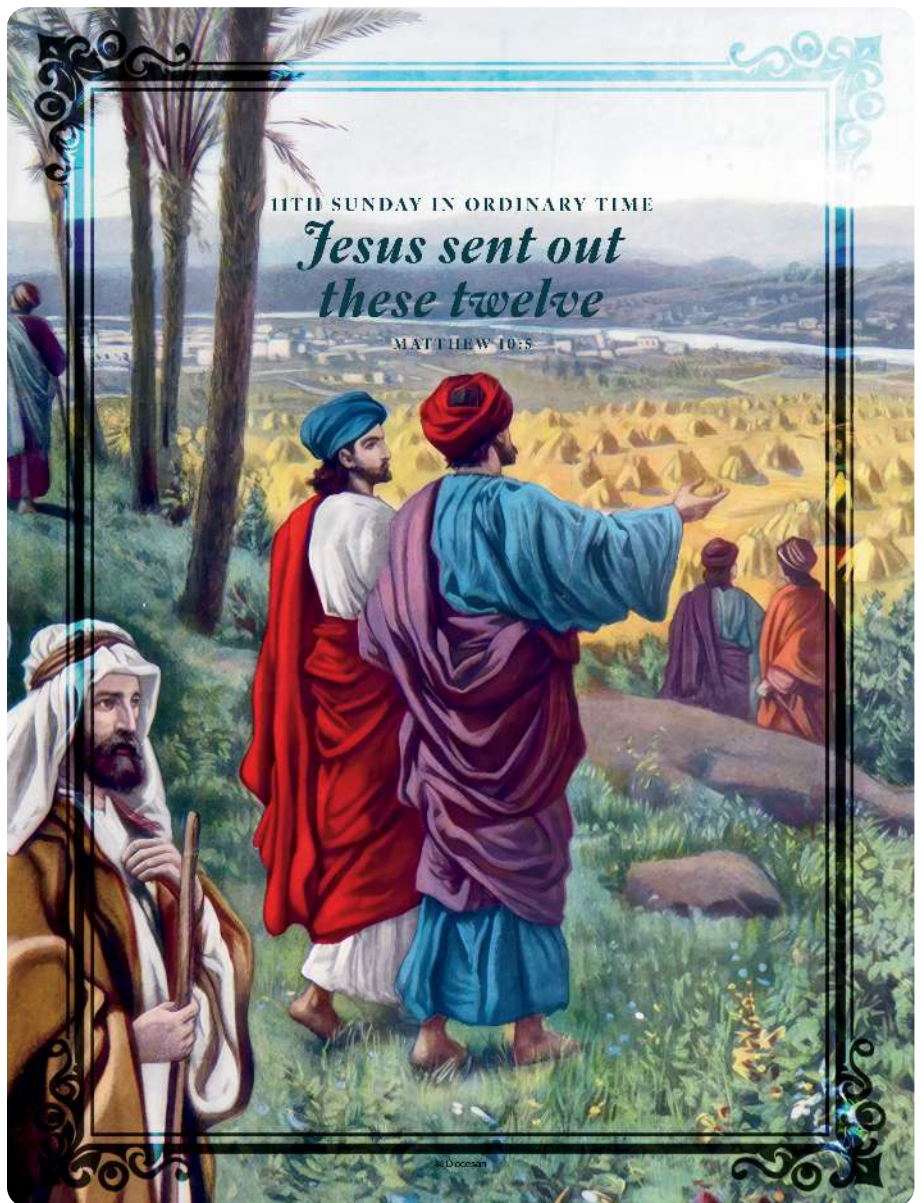

### Behind the Collar: Meet Your Deacons

This week we asked Deacon Pete Jupin and Deacon Mike Oles the same question: *What was the most challenging, or most rewarding, part of their formation journey to the diaconate?*

Their answers are a beautiful reminder that God calls ordinary men through very ordinary circumstances.

**Deacon Pete Jupin:** The hardest part for all of us was an overwhelming sense of unworthiness to be called to this office. We were quickly reminded, though, that we were not worthy on our own, but made worthy through Christ. Balancing work, family, and studies was a real challenge too. The most rewarding part was watching our brothers and ourselves grow deeper in faith and come to new understandings of what it means to share that faith with others.

**Deacon Mike Oles:** The hardest part for me was keeping up with the work while in the early years of my teaching career. In fact, up until two weeks before ordination, I wasn't sure I was going to be ordained. When I finally went before Bishop Lori to sign the necessary document, I was so moved I had tears running down my cheeks. When he passed me his beautiful fountain pen to sign, I pressed down hard and it wouldn't write. The Bishop gently told me that if I rotated the pen 180 degrees, it would work better!

## PARISH HEALTH MINISTRY (PHM)

With the end of the school year and summer (with its longer days) upon us, our planning of family adventures gives us the chance to explore this beautiful world. Whether traveling across the country or enjoying a weekend getaway, a little preparation goes a long way toward keeping everyone safe, healthy, and stress-free.

### Plan Ahead for Smooth Travel

- Check travel documents early – Ensure IDs, passports, and insurance cards are up to date.
- Share your itinerary – Let a trusted friend or family member know your travel plans.
- Research your destination – Look up weather, local safety alerts, and any health advisories.
- Book wisely – Confirm reservations for lodging, transportation, and activities before you go

### Stay Healthy on the Road

- Hydrate often – Summer heat can sneak up quickly, especially for children and older adults.
- Pack a small health kit – Include sunscreen (SPF 30+), insect repellent, bandages, pain relievers, and any prescription medications.
- Protect against ticks and mosquitoes – Use repellent, wear light, long sleeves in wooded areas, and check for ticks after outdoor activities.
- Know your limits – Rest when needed, especially during long drives or hikes.

### Keep Safety First

- Road travel – Have your vehicle serviced, check tires, and keep an emergency kit in the trunk.
- Air travel – Allow extra time for security, keep medications in carry-on bags, and sanitize hands frequently. Keep devices charged for digital boarding passes.
- Water safety – Supervise children near pools, lakes, and beaches; follow posted warnings; wear life jackets when boating.
- Heat awareness – Never leave children or pets in a parked car, even briefly. Drink water frequently in the heat.

### Protect Your Home While Away

- Use timers for lights to make your home look occupied.
- Pause mail or ask a neighbor to collect it.
- Secure windows and doors before leaving.
- Avoid posting travel plans publicly on social media until after you return.

### Travel with a Spirit of Gratitude

As you explore new places or revisit familiar ones, take time to notice God's presence—in the beauty of nature, in the people you meet, and in the rest He provides.

May your summer journeys be safe, refreshing, and filled with blessings.

## CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD AT SJN: A FOUR-PART GLIMPSE INTO THE ATRIUM

### Part 4: Following the Child

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is deeply rooted in the Montessori principle of “following the child,” but always with Christ at the center. Rather than rushing children from activity to activity, the Atrium allows space for repetition, contemplation, movement, silence, and wonder. Children may return to the same work many times because something in it continues to speak to them spiritually.

This approach requires extraordinary preparation and discernment from catechists.

At SJN, Barbara Goss leads this ministry with expertise formed through countless hours of formation, prayer, study, observation of working atriums across the country, and faithful dedication to the call God has placed on her heart. Her leadership has helped create an Atrium culture where children are treated with deep respect as persons capable of profound relationship with God.



Our catechists spend significant time preparing presentations, studying Scripture, reflecting on child development, restoring materials, and prayerfully considering how best to meet the spiritual needs of each age level. As Barbara recently reflected regarding our growing Level II Atrium, the challenge is not simply managing activity but helping older children balance activity with reflection as they enter a deeper stage of spiritual development. This ministry could not flourish without the many catechists, assistants, and families who support it with generosity and love. Perhaps the clearest sign of its fruit is simple:

Children leave the Atrium still wondering.

Wondering about the Kingdom of God.

Wondering about Jesus.

Wondering about the Holy Spirit.

Wondering what God may someday write on the “blank page” of their own lives.

That wonder is holy ground.



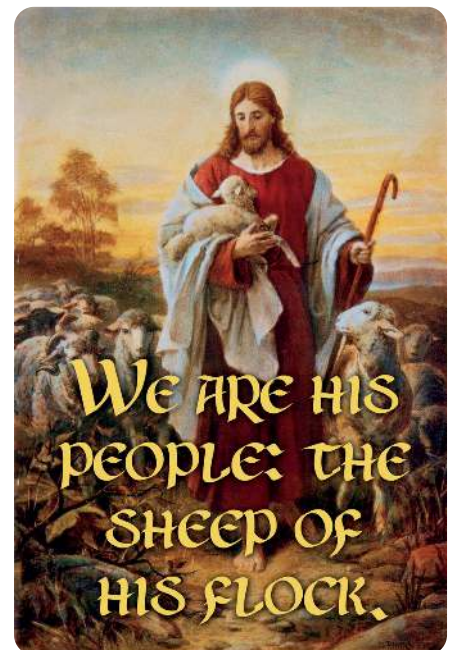
