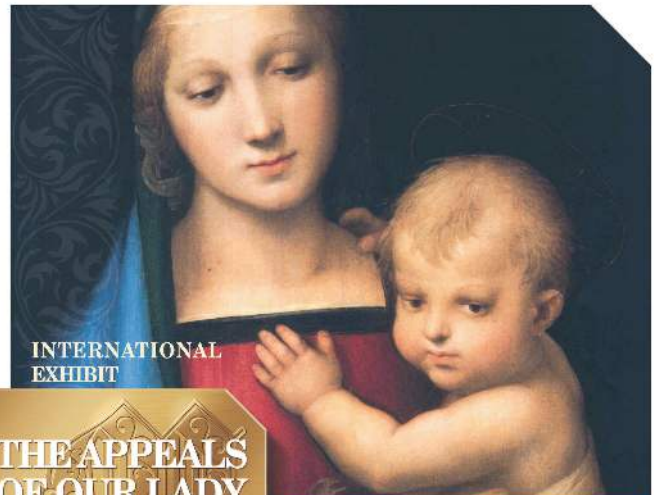
When did you first feel the call to the diaconate, and what was it about the ministry of service that spoke to you?

**Deacon Mike Oles:** Way back in 1995, I had no idea what the diaconate was really about, except that we had a deacon at our parish in Connecticut who would serve at the altar and occasionally preach. One day I approached my pastor and said I'd like to become a deacon. I was surprised when he told me he'd put me in touch with the Diaconate Office in the Diocese. I had assumed the pastor just appointed men to be deacons. I had no idea this was a multi-year process of discernment, prayer, and study!

**Deacon Pete Jupin:** I first felt my calling to the diaconate in early adulthood as I reflected on my many blessings and how good God had been to me. In this spirit of thanksgiving, I came to realize that God's love is meant to be shared with others in service and charity. It was pretty clear to me: there was no holding on to it. As Christ loves us, so we are to love others.

## Parish Health Ministry (PHM)

May is the month we dedicate to Mary, our Blessed Mother. And today is Mother's Day, where we are invited to reflect and honor the women whose love has shaped our lives. In every season of life - be it joyful, ordinary, or difficult - mothers reveal something of God's tenderness. For Catholics, this day also draws our hearts to Mary, the Blessed Mother, whose faithful "yes" to God opened the way for our salvation and whose maternal love continues to guide the Church.

Mary's motherhood began in quiet humility at the Annunciation, when she entrusted her whole life to God's plan. She carried Jesus within her, nurtured Him in His younger years, and walked beside Him during His public ministry. She knew the joys of raising a child and the sorrows that come with loving deeply. And when He was crucified, she remained steadfast, faithful, and unafraid to love even when love meant suffering.

At the foot of the Cross, Jesus entrusted Mary to the beloved disciple with the words, "Behold, your mother" (John 19:27). In that moment, Mary's motherhood expanded to embrace all of us. She became the mother who intercedes, comforts, and accompanies every individual who seeks her Son. Her presence reminds us that no one walks the path of faith alone.

On this Mother's Day, we honor the mothers, grandmothers, godmothers, and spiritual mothers in our lives; women who, like Mary, reflect God's compassion through their daily sacrifices and quiet acts of love. Whether they are with us or held in memory, we give thanks for the ways they have nurtured our faith, strengthened our families, and taught us how to love generously. May this day be a moment of gratitude and blessing. And may Mary, our Blessed Mother wrap every mother in her peace and guide them ever closer to the heart of her Son.

**"Set healthy boundaries"**. We hear that advice all the time, whether we're talking about screen time, work-life balance or relationships. But what does it mean? How do we set healthy boundaries? When we set boundaries, we give ourselves permission to prioritize what matters most, reduce stress and burnout, and create space for healthier relationships — with our friends, coworkers, the office, our phones or a loved one. Without boundaries, it's easy to become overwhelmed quickly. Constantly saying "yes" when you really mean "no" takes a lot of energy and time, leading to stress, anxiety and burnout. But saying "no" doesn't sound like a good thing, does it? We want to be helpful and valued, and saying "no" might make us feel guilty or selfish.
