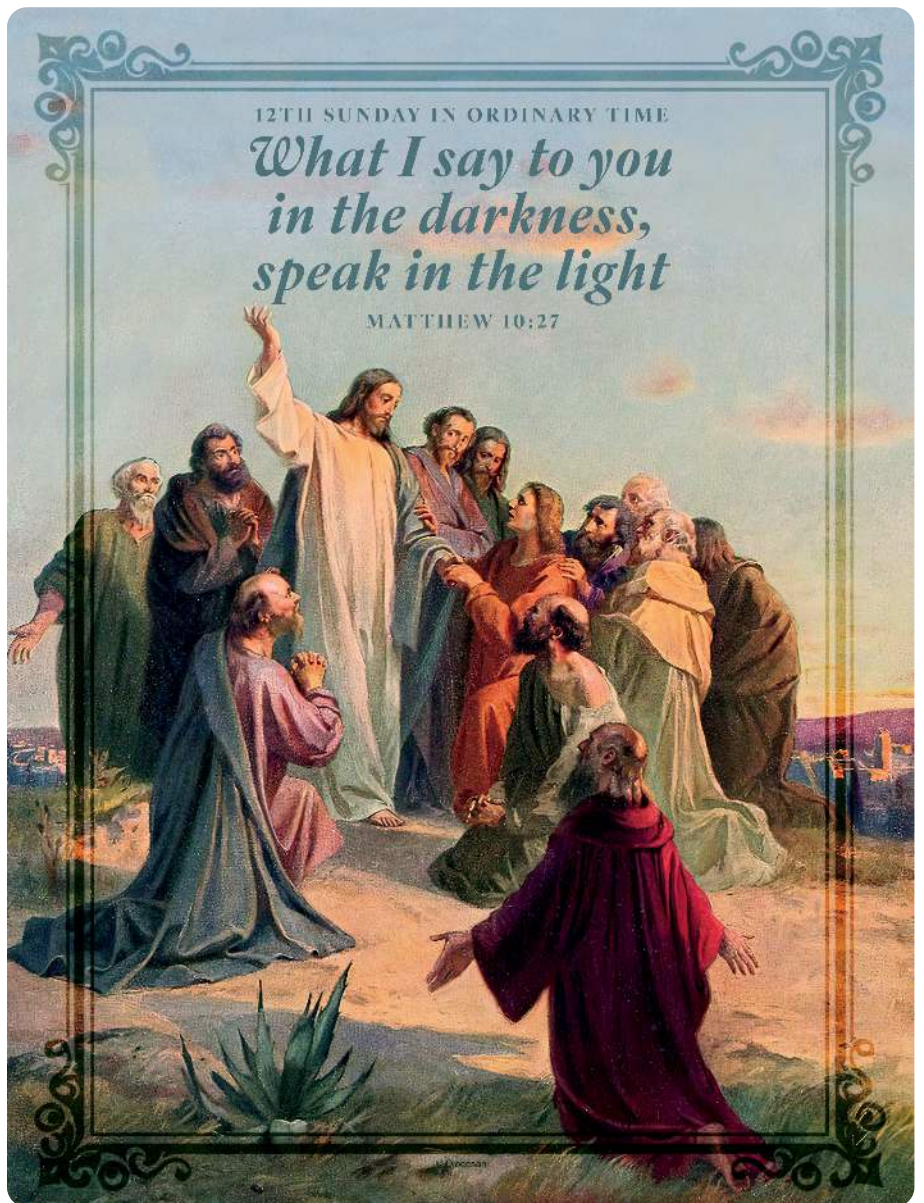

Holy matrimony calls spouses to place Christ at the center of their lives and to reflect His love by cherishing and serving one another. Could God be inviting you to this vocation of faithful love and self-sacrifice? If so, seek guidance from a married couple you admire and ask how they live out their commitment to each other and to Christ.

Behind the Collar: Meet Your Deacons

This week, we asked Deacon Mike Oles and Deacon Pete Jupin about a ministry or act of charity close to their hearts.

Deacon Mike Oles: In 2009, I founded Off The Streets, a program that has helped more than 12,000 people, 80 percent of them women and children, move into their own apartments. The program has no paid staff and runs almost entirely on donations for security deposits, with furniture and other living needs donated as well. We've grown to 15 chapters across Connecticut, Pennsylvania, California, Washington, Maryland, New York, and Ohio, and our hope is to keep reaching across the country to help the homeless, off the streets, one person at a time.

Deacon Pete Jupin: That's an unfair question, I won't play favorites! But I can say that visiting the sick and dying remains close to my heart, because of how courageously many people open their hearts to God and unite their suffering with that of Christ. We talk about this all the time, but to witness and accompany it in person is a special privilege. There are many beautiful and sublime moments of faith, hope, and certainly love.

Pray for Our Quo Vadis Days Participants

This week, young men from our diocese head to Mount St. Mary's Seminary for Quo Vadis Days (June 21-25), a chance to grow in faith and listen for God's call. Please keep them in your prayers.

Lord Jesus, be with these young men this week. Open their hearts to hear your voice, and give them courage to follow wherever you lead. Amen.
